

Privacy of Student Information – Opt-Out Form

Students and parents have rights, under state and federal laws, to control the release of student information.

Submit this form if you DO NOT want information about your student given to military recruiters (and/or to colleges). Act 127 of the Vermont Legislature, passed in 2006, provides for “separate” opt-out rights. If you do not submit this form or a similar letter, the school is allowed to release information to recruiters or colleges.

Military Recruiting Information Opt-Out

I do NOT want the school to release any information about my student to military recruiters.

College Recruiting Information Opt-Out

I do NOT want the school to release any information about my student to colleges.

Please note:

You also have the right to direct the school not to release other information, often called “student directory information,” to other organizations and entities. Typically, this information is given to newspapers for a student’s listing in sporting events, honor roll, or other school activities. Also, there are times when a school is required by law to provide certain information to certain agencies. Contact your school for more information about your family’s privacy rights.
