### 2020 Vermonter Poll Methodology

Data were collected by the Center for Rural Studies at the University of Vermont as part of the 2020 Vermonter Poll. The survey was conducted between the hours of 12:00 p.m. and 8:30 p.m. beginning on February 18, 2020 and ending March 1, 2020. Telephone polling was conducted from the University of Vermont using computer-aided telephone interviewing (CATI). A random sample for the poll was drawn from lists of Vermont landline and cellular telephone numbers. Only Vermont residents over the age of eighteen were interviewed. The poll included questions on a variety of subject areas relevant to Vermonters.

A total of 559 Vermont residents over the age of 18 agreed to participate and completed the survey. Based upon 559 valid responses, the overall study results have a margin of error of plus or minus 4.1 percent with a confidence level of 95 percent. This means that if this study were replicated 100 times, 95 of those times, the results would fall within +/-4.1% of the results found in this effort.
