

DLS RESPONSE PROGRESSION

STEP #1: DIVERSION REFERRAL

DIVERSION HAS COMMITTED TO REQUIRE PARTICIPANTS TO:

- OBTAIN REINSTATEMENT OF THEIR LICENSE OR OBTAIN RDL
 - MEET FINANCIAL OBLIGATIONS ASSOCIATED WITH REINSTATEMENT
-

In the event of a case kicking back from Diversion.

STEP #2: Either offer to rerefer the individual to Diversion, or make the following offer:

“If you obtain reinstatement of your license within ___ days (120?), the State will recommend the mandatory minimum \$300 fine. All of this fine may be suspended if you show your valid photo license, reinstatement letter, and insurance certificate to the court clerk. It will take longer than you think to get your license back, so start today. If you do not get your license back, the State will recommend 9-10 days work crew.”

At least one rereferral to Diversion is encouraged, unless Diversion has indicated that Defendant is ineligible for rereferral.

If Defendant still hasn't gotten their license back by the deadline or after rereferral(s) to Diversion.

STEP #3: STICK TO YOUR GUNS

- ENFORCE THE OFFER DEADLINE.
- CONFIRM OFFER 9-10 DAYS WORK CREW.
- STAY FIRM ON YOUR OFFER AND DEVIATE ONLY IN EXCEPTIONAL CASES.
